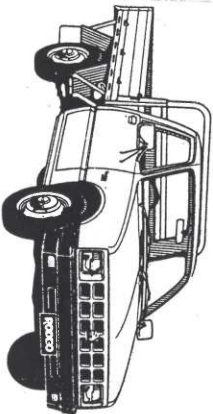
Hi all,
