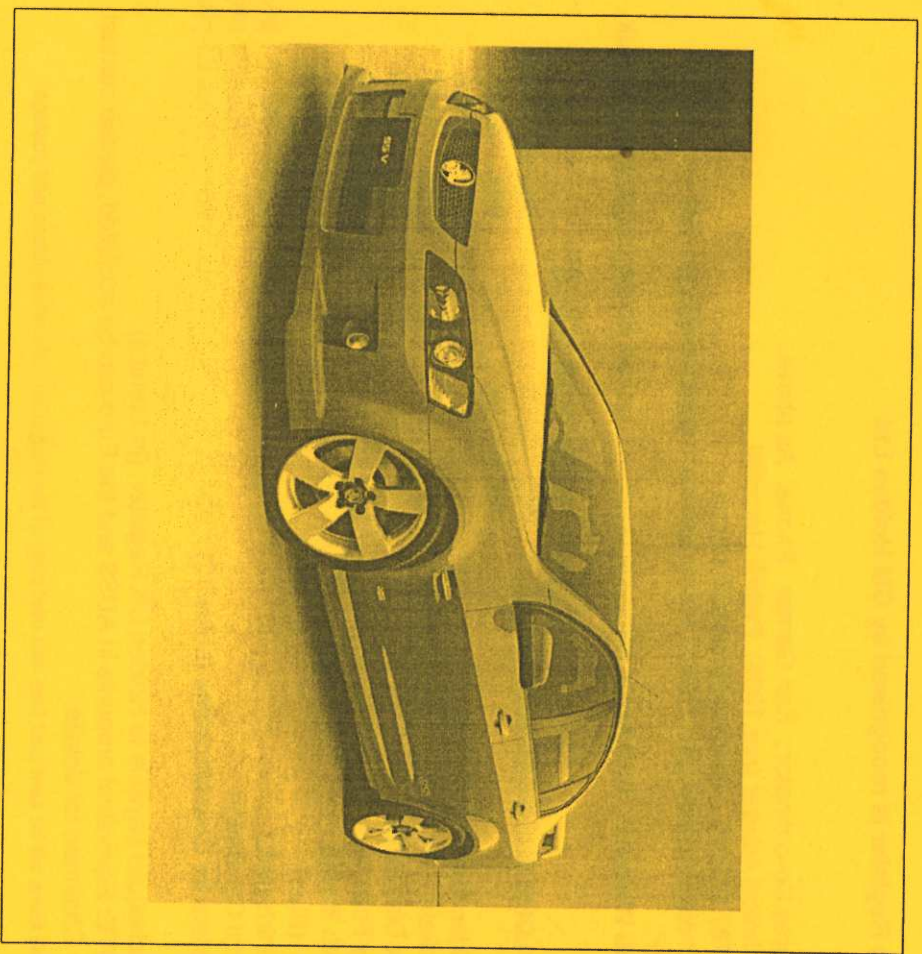


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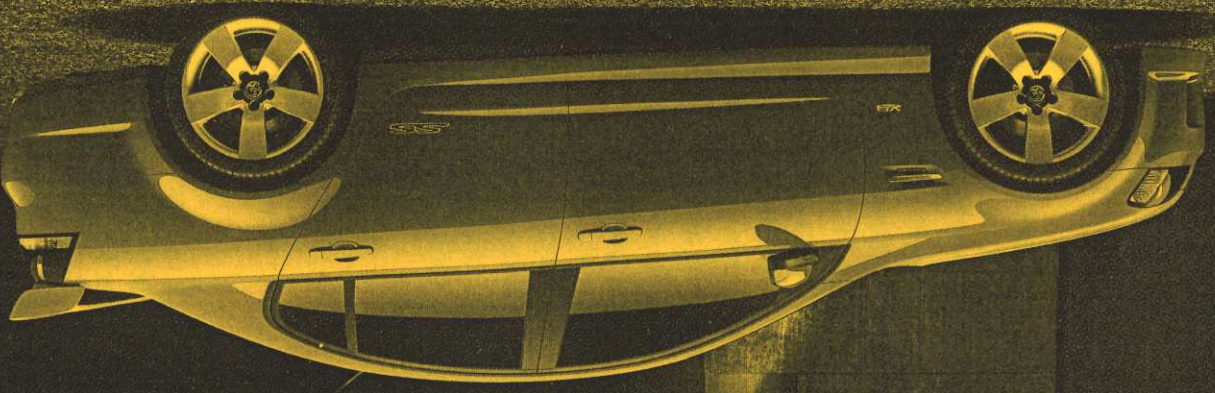

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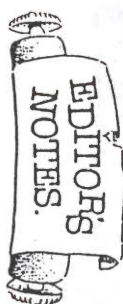

## Update of Holden Commodore 1998 VTSS

Further to your request for updated information on members' cars I have had the following changes made to my 1998 Holden VTSS and thought you might like to hear about them.

I had an LPG Generation 3 Tartarini sequential injection system installed in the Holden. This is done through a 100-litre Australian fuel tank, which has specific mounting points to exact specifications for the Holden. There is also a concealed fuel filter input behind the existing fuel flap already installed in the Holden for LPG, even on a car of this age. The tank was imported from Holden, Homebush in Parramatta, Sydney. There has been no noticeable loss of performance at all when running on LPG.

The reason for the LPG installation is that we hope to re-import our Holden back to Australia for a world tour of Australia and New Zealand for our gap year once we retire! The car is welcome to stay in Australia but we are not as the Holden is a natural born Australian citizen.
